- E.1-E.9 - Numbers and counting beyond 20
- F.1-F.4 - Skip Counting
- G.4-G.7 - Comparing
- H.1-H.3 - Patterns
- I.1-I.6 - Addition up to 5
- J.1-J.8 - Addition up to 10
- K.1-K.5 - Subtraction up to 5
- L.1-L.7 - Subtraction up to 10
- M.1-M.6 - Positions
- P.6-P.7 - Sorting, ordering, and classifying
- Q.1-Q.2 - Data and graphs
- R.1 - Probability
- T.1-T.4 - Money
- U.1 - Vocabulary
- V.5 - Geometry
