Your first math test grade of the school year will be based on the number of problems you completed on IXL. This goal of 1,000 problems is much easier to achieve than it may seem. While you do *not* have to master any particular math skill, you do have to complete at least 1,000 problems to receive an A grade.

The rubric is:

1,000+ Problems	A
900-999 Problems	B
800-899 Problems	C
700-799 Problems	D

For every 200 problems that you complete over 1,000, you will earn a fun prize. The more problems that you complete, the bigger the prizes! After you have completed the list of skills above, you can then choose any 3rd grade skill to earn the bonus prizes.
